Agency Overview

HopeWorks' mission is to support and advocate for people in Howard County affected by sexual and intimate partner violence and to engage the community in creating the change required for violence prevention.

Advocacy Services

- 24-Hour Hotline for connection to services, resources, referrals, and information: (410) 997-2272
- Hospital Accompaniment Program providing comfort, support, and advocacy to survivors of sexual violence, intimate partner violence, and human trafficking at Johns Hopkins Howard County Medical Center
- Short-term advocacy case management for survivors of sexual violence and intimate partner violence. Long-term advocacy case management for shelter clients
- Lethality Assessment Program providing outreach to referrals received from Howard County Police Department, Sheriff's Office, and DSS

Shelter Services

- Crisis shelter for survivors (and their children) of intimate partner violence and sexual violence
- Transitional housing for eligible shelter clients
- Educational programs and life-skill trainings

Counseling Services

- Available for people of all ages and genders, and available to children 6 years old and up
- Crisis appointments
- Individual and group counseling
- Women's Support Group (call for registration details)
- Animal-assisted therapy

Legal Services

- Brief advice, information, and referrals for survivors of intimate partner violence, sexual violence, stalking, and child abuse
- Representation and consultation in peace & protective order matters
- Consultation in crime victims' rights, divorce, custody, and other family law proceedings
- Court accompaniment for survivors of intimate partner violence and sexual violence

Anti-Trafficking Services

- Safety planning for survivors of human trafficking and referral to TurnAround, Inc. for shelter and case management services

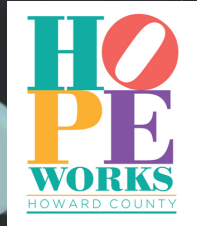
