# Agency Overview

HopeWorks' mission is to support and advocate for people in Howard County affected by sexual and intimate partner violence and to engage the community in creating the change required for violence prevention.

## Advocacy Services

- 24-hour Hotline for connection to services, resources, referrals, and information: (410) 997-2272
- Hospital Accompaniment Program providing comfort, support, and advocacy to adult and child survivors at Johns Hopkins Howard County Medical Center.
- Short-term advocacy case management for all clients. Long-term advocacy case management on a case-by-case basis.
- Lethality Assessment Program providing outreach to referrals from the Howard County Police Department, Sheriff's Office, and Department of Social Services.

## Shelter Services

- 60-day crisis shelter for survivors and their children.
- 45-day Extended Shelter Program and 6-month Transitional Housing Program for eligible shelter clients.
- Educational programs, transportation, and life-skills trainings.

## Clinical Counseling Services

- Available for adults of all genders, and children 6 years old and up
- Scheduled crisis appointments
- Individual and group counseling, as well as animal-assisted therapy
- Weekly Support Group (call for registration details)

## Legal Services

- Brief advice, information, and referrals for survivors of sexual and intimate partner violence, stalking, human trafficking, and child abuse
- Representation and consultation in peace & protective order matters
- Consultation on crime victims' rights, divorce, custody, and other family law proceedings
- Court accompaniment for survivors of intimate partner violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking

- Prevention education for Youth and Adults
- Trainings for the workplace, as well as outreach and awareness events
- The Survivor Support, Wellbeing, & Education Programs: the Health Project and the Healing Arts Project
